Notice Concerning Dividends of Surplus (Increase in Dividends)

The Yamagata Bank, Ltd. ("the Bank") hereby announces that the dividends of surplus with a record date of March 31, 2026 have been resolved at the Board of Directors held on May 15, 2026. Details are described as below.

1. Details of dividends

2. Reason

Regarding shareholder returns, as stated in the "Notice Concerning the Review of Shareholder Return Policy" announced on February 9, 2026, the Bank has adopted a progressive dividend policy targeting a dividend payout ratio of 40%.

While the year-end dividend for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 was initially planned at ¥50 per share, in light of the above policy and the financial results for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026, the Bank has decided to increase the dividend by ¥6 to ¥56 per share.

As a result, the total annual dividends per share for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026 are ¥84, including the interim dividend of ¥28.
